



Delinquent in your utility bills? Contact DCCAA at 843-917-8249 for assistance.

A new policy is in effect immediately: If your water is disconnected for non-payment, all trash receptacles will be removed from your premises until past due bills are brought current.

The Town of Lamar and Darlington Trash Disposal sites **DO NOT HAVE THE CAPACITY TO RECYCLE**. There is no need to sort your trash and use the blue bins. We do ask you to please crush and reduce all boxes to a manageable size. Please make sure all bags are tied. If the bags are too heavy, the bags will tear. Please dispose of your trash twice per week!

Thank you to all customers who pay their bills in a timely manner. Remember, you can pay on-line or use the drop box at Town Hall.
