This month's featured merchant is Tina's Café (formerly known as Main Street Café) located at 131 West Main Street. Owned and operated by the Wong family, the family has been restaurateurs and residents of Lamar for 15 years.

"When we moved to Lamar to start a Chinese restaurant, many said it will never make it here. We worked hard and bought the best ingredients, producing dishes that made the restaurant grow." Tina says. "We were blessed that the people of this community liked what we were serving." The Wong family later sold the restaurant to start a new venture of what has become Tina's Café.

Tina's Café has been open for over 5 years and features traditional southern cuisine with an Asian fusion. Local favorites include the Cheeseburger Egg Roll, Fried Dill Pickles, Teriyaki Chicken Bowl, Philly Cheesesteak, Chicken Quesadilla, Fried Flounder and Shrimp Dinner, Hamburger Steak, and of course Chicken Wings tossed in their homemade sauces.

There are daily lunch specials and a country buffet from 10:30 till 2:00 Monday through Friday. Chef specials and seasonal featured menu items are written on the white board as well. Open Daily from 10:30am till 8:30pm Monday through Saturday with limited in door dining seating available.

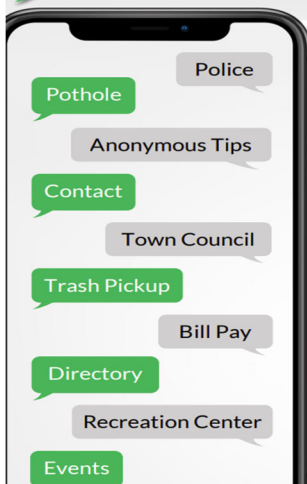

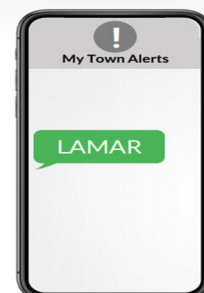

- You will receive up to 4 text messages a month with a notification for each alert category selection.

How to Opt-Out:

Text STOP at any time to remove yourself from the notification list.

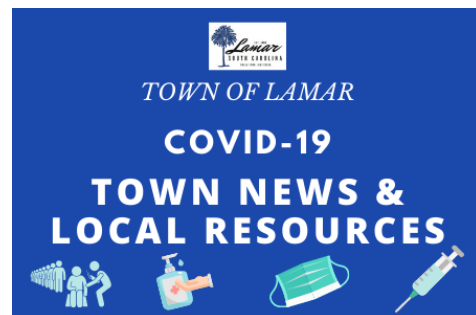
