Dear Merchant:

With the adoption of the South Carolina Business License Tax Standardization Act by the South Carolina General Assembly, all municipalities in South Carolina must comply with the requirements of Act 176.

Your 2021-2022 Business License expires on April 30, 2022, and your 2022-2023 Business License will be due on May 1, 2022. For the 2022-2023 license year the Town is granting an additional 30 day pay period until May 31, 2022, before assessing a 5 % per month penalty allowed by the business license ordinance.

For the 2022-2023 Business License Year, all businesses will pay \$100.00. Additionally, businesses applying for a 2022-2023 Business License must provide proof of their gross income based on the prior calendar year (tax returns, letter from a CPA, itemization of services, etc.). Council intends to evaluate the information that is collected and beginning with the 2023-2024 Business License Year, implement a standardized class schedule.

Please return the completed business license application along with your fee by May 16, 2022, and your new business license and paid receipt will be mailed to you. You can also return your application and fee to Lamar Town Hall.
